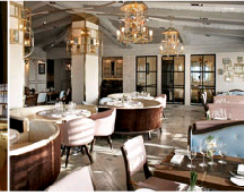

From the indoor/outdoor "casita" booths to the fascinating array of Spanish antiques, Casa in Downtown Los Angeles pays homage to everything Mexican. Designed by Ana Henton, a protégé of Frank Gehry, the spectacular space is inspired by a modern hacienda - think smooth adobe stucco, curved walls and even a (non-tacky) water fountain. Head chef Kris Morningstar oversees a kitchen that serves contemporary Mexican cuisine that includes standouts such as 'conejo' (braised rabbit with chestnuts, roasted cauliflower, cinnamon, ancho chile and almonds). The piece de resistance? Expertly mixed, highly potent cocktails such as the signature Margarita finished with a rim of house-smoked salt.
